- Be specific yet concise
- Use different type faces to break up text
- Quantify your tasks
- Think outside the box when listing skills and abilities

- Use keywords from job listing
- Have people you trust review résumé for constructive criticism
- Make sure to list "References available upon request"

- Carmine 'The Roman' Falcone, notorious mafia mob boss and drug lord who managed a criminal network trafficking \$26 million of illicit substances weekly
- Jonathan "Scarecrow" Crane, expert user of psychological tactics to exploit the fears and phobias of his adversaries
- Ra's al Ghul, environmental nutcase whose goal to eliminate humanity through biological warfare threatened the lives of millions

Acing the Interview

- Quit job before finding a replacement
- Assume you are over/under-qualified
 Apply first, analyze later
- Post anything on social media sites your grandparents would not approve
 Consider blocking your profile(s) during application
- Show up late
- Think that you have job security
- Bombard HR/interviewer with phone calls or emails
